The Board voted to extend our "adult children window" to all immediate relatives of existing members, including adult children of all ages, parents, siblings, grandparents and grandchildren. It would not apply to cousins and other "non-immediate" family members. In addition, the family member could apply at a category of membership different from the proposing family member, e.g., a tennis member's brother could join as a regular member, and still benefit from the "window" of no initiation. This family member opportunity was adopted by the Board, for applications prior to November 15, 2013.
